



## 2020 R&V Fall Fest Event Details and Reminders

### **\*\*\*PLEASE READ\*\*\***

Looking forward to a great 4 days of enjoying the outdoors while listening to Original Acoustic Music! This email includes more details about the event as well as some very important reminders of the changes being made to help make your experience the best possible! So here we go....

- This is a private event for those who have already purchased a campsite and/or tickets. This event is now SOLD OUT and no tickets will be available at the gate.
- Alcohol will not be allowed in the stage area but bars will be set up to serve customers. BYOB is still allowed in the camping areas.
- The Jalapeno popper cook-off and the Home Brew competition will not take place this year because of the difficulty involved in complying with social distancing, sanitation, etc.
- To ensure the safety of the artists, all entertainment will be acoustic with no more than three people on stage at a time
- All entertainment will take place outside/open air to enhance the safety for the attendees, staff and performers.

- Masks will be required in the stage area unless seated with your group.
- Seating areas will be spaced out and marked off to ensure the proper distance maintained between attendees along with designated walkways.
- Over 20 hand sanitizing stations
- Patrons may exit the fenced off venue to use their own camper restrooms if they wish.
- Please bring your own lawn chairs.
- Limited space is available for Easy-Up tents, but they must be no larger than 10 ft x 10 ft.
- Seating will be first come first serve in marked off locations.

### **Bars and Concessions:**

- 3 remote outdoor locations
- Universal tabs (start a tab at one bar, order from any bar after that)
- Ability to run tabs without swiping credit cards if preferred
- Beer buckets available and encouraged
- Pre-packaged straws & condiments
- One use plastic cups

### **What's not allowed during this year's Rhymes & Vines:**

- Dancing in front of stage
- Unfortunately there will be **no VIP areas** this year due to the safety of entertainers and inability to provide spacing needed to social distance. We will, however, offer existing VIP holders the options for reserved up front seating, meal vouchers, T-shirts and more.
- VIP's may pick up their packets at the ticket gate
- No backstage or artist access

### **Social Distancing and COVID-19 Reminders:**

- We know everyone has different levels of social distancing and some of you are in groups. PLEASE respect other patrons...you can do this by refraining from hugging, hand shaking, high five or any other type of greeting with patrons not in your group.
- Staff will require a temperature check each day
- Frequently touched surfaces & other objects cleaned & disinfected multiple times a day

### **Camping & Ticket Gate Times**

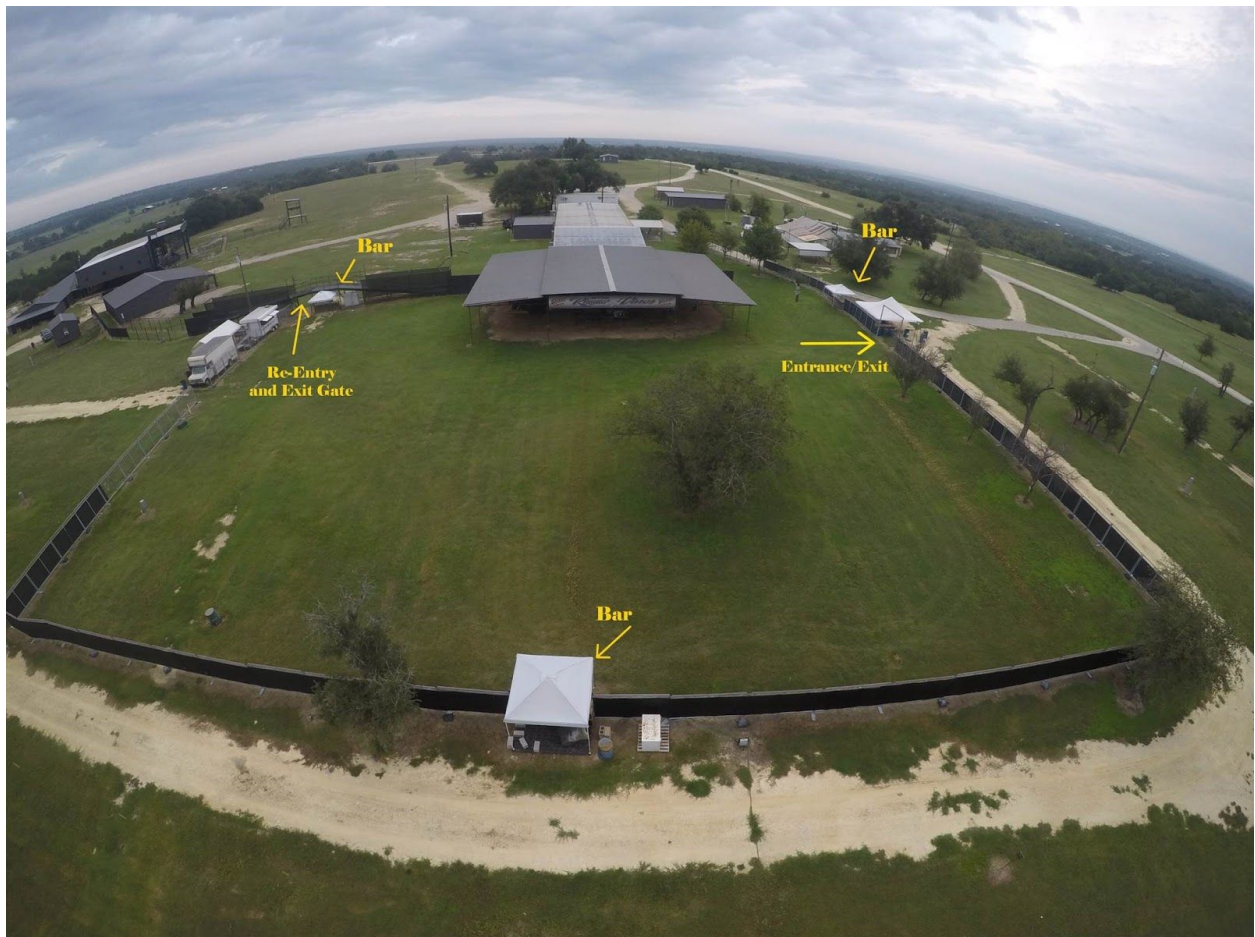
Please print out your tickets before arrival. You tickets will be taken at the entrance to the stage area. Everyone must enter on the east side of the stage FIRST to exchange your ticket for an armband. There will be an additional re-entry gate on the west side of the stage for patrons that already have armbands.

Camping check in will happen on the main road where the road Y's, not at the front gate building. Please have your decal on the driver's side windshield before entering the campground. If you need help finding your site, there will be camping locators at that point.
