

GREETINGS!

Travel Warning (Road Closures) - at times they are closing US Highway 64, the road between Cimarron and Eagles Nest. Since the big fire, it is prone to flash flooding and mudslides. You can call the Cimarron City Hall at (576) 376-2232 to find out the status of the road on the day you are traveling. The alternate route would be to go through Taos.

The purpose of this email is to provide information regarding where to pick up your tickets and armbands for LJT's 2018 "Hot Chili Days, Cool Mountain Nights" Music Festival in Red River, NM as well as additional information about each show.

If you ordered advance tickets you should have received them in an email form. Please print and bring to the ticket gate on the day of the event to exchange them for an armband. If you ordered multiple tickets please make sure you print each ticket and make sure they are not the same ticket number. If you do not have access to a printer, bring your email attachment on your phone to the ticket gates. Ticket handlers will also be able to look up tickets to the event if neither option is available.


How do I get my armbands?

Wednesday

If you have Package A, Package A VIP, or Wednesday night tickets you may exchange your ticket for an armband at this time.

The ticket gate will be open from 3 pm – 5 pm at the Motherlode Saloon on Wednesday, August 15th. After 5 pm, Wednesday night ticket holders and package ticket holders may pick up their armbands at Bitter Creek Ranch beginning at 6 pm. The address for the event is 178 Bitter Creek Rd, Red River NM 87558. This is approximately 2.4 miles from the Motherlode Saloon

Thursday

If you have VIP, Package A, B or Thursday night tickets, you may exchange your ticket for an armband at this time.

Ticket gate will open at 4 pm at the Motherlode Saloon on Thursday, August 16th. You may pick up your armbands at that time.

What if I bought tickets to an event later in the week?

Tickets can be exchanged for armbands at each event gate. For example, if you ordered tickets for the Saturday park show, you may pick up your armband at the Saturday park gate.

What if I need more tickets?

Tickets will be on sale for each event at the gate and online during all the events unless they are sold out (please check website for availability). At 4 pm on Thursday tickets will be available at the Motherlode Saloon throughout the afternoon and evening.

Other information

Please remember that the weather in Red River can change quickly so be prepared for warm, cool and rainy weather at all times! It is also a good idea to bring sunscreen for outdoor events.

What to bring to each event:

Wednesday Bitter Creek Ranch Show

This is an outdoor show. The address is 178 Bitter Creek Rd, Red River NM 87558. This is approximately 2.4 miles from the Motherlode saloon. Parking is available at this event. Dinner will be served at 6:30 pm followed by a performance with Ray Wylie Hubbard. There are chairs and tables available at this event but if you wish to bring your own there is limited space for personal seating. Beverages will be available for purchase. No outside food or drinks allowed.

The Lost Love Saloon Shows

These are free shows located inside the Red River Lodge & Texas Reds Steak House. This is an inside venue. Food & bar service available.

Motherlode Saloon Shows

Motherlode shows will be held inside except for Thursday night which will be outside. All shows at the Motherlode Saloon are 21 and up. State Law requires everyone to have their ID on them. No outside food or drinks allowed.

Mountain Top Show

In order to get to the show you will ride the ski lift to the top of the mountain. If you ordered tickets in advance, Ski lift tickets are included in the ticket price. Gates open at 10 am. Once on the lift, it takes approximately 30 minutes to get to the top. There will be a line so get there early to avoid missing the show. There is an inside area with food, bar service and restrooms. Bring sunscreen, warm clothes and rain gear just in case.

Friday at Brandenburg Park

This is an outdoor show. Bring blankets or lawn chairs for seating. We also recommend sunscreen, warm clothes and rain gear. Gates open at 2 pm. If you also have Saturday Park Tickets bring those with you as well. You will be able to exchange both tickets for an armband that will be valid for both days. No outside food or drinks allowed.

Saturday Brandenburg Park Show

This is an outdoor show. Bring blankets and lawn chairs for seating. We also recommend sunscreen, warm clothes and rain gear. Food and bar service will be available inside the park. Restrooms are located inside the convention center next to the park. Gates open at 9 am. No outside food or drinks allowed.
